

UNIVERSITY PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM SUMMARY

The National Society of Hispanic MBAs (NSHMBA) invites you to participate in the University Partnership Program (UPP). This program was created by NSHMBA to help your university expand the pool of qualified Hispanic students who apply for financial assistance that enables them to complete master's degrees in business. Together we can make strides in achieving the goal of increasing diversity.

This document serves as an overview of the University Partnership Program. As a part of the program, your institution agrees to provide one or multiple partial to full in-kind scholarships, fellowships, or assistantship to graduate student studying in the university's AACSB (Association to Advance Collegiate Schools of Business) accredited business program. The expectation would be that these awards would continue for years to come unless terminated at any time by written notice of either party. Specific program guidelines and timeline are provided separately and updated on a yearly basis.

Program Information

The amount of each award may cover full tuition and fees for each graduate student selected by the university. In order to apply for this award, the student must first be admitted to the university and/or program. The university reserves the right to solely determine admission criteria for its programs. The university will be solely responsible for determining the eligibility of each candidate beyond the minimum criteria, for evaluating candidates, and for awarding the scholarship, fellowship, or assistantship. The university must notify NSHMBA of the award recipient including contact information and amount awarded.

Minimum Eligibility for Student Scholarship Applicants

- Be United States citizen or legal permanent resident
- Preference may be given but is not limited to students of Hispanic heritage or students with a demonstrated commitment to the Hispanic community
- Have a minimum grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale (or the equivalent) from either a bachelor's degree or master's degree
- Enroll in the AACSB accredited program

Outreach for Applicants for the Scholarship/Fellowship/Assistantship through NSHMBA

To help the university expand the pool of qualified Hispanic applicants for scholarship/ fellowship/assistantship opportunities, NSHMBA will make a good-faith effort to identify candidates to apply to the university for such opportunities by providing assistance without charge in outreach and advertising in the following areas:
