DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

Upon formal admission to the full-time MBA/MIB program, a student must fulfill the following requirements in order to receive both degrees of this dual-degree program:

- 1) A minimum of 64.5 credits of approved graduate-level coursework
- 2) The appropriate distribution of required core courses and elective courses
- 3) A minimum cumulative quality point average (QPA) of 3.0 (B)
- 4) Students must declare an area of concentration of study to which elective credits must be applied
